1. Any vandalism or attempted vandalism will result in immediate suspension from school. **SEE ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY** (August 1999)

3. Certain flash drives are not compatible with La Salle's network.
4. Students may not access the internet unless a teacher or teacher assistant is present, and a signed consent form is on file.
5. La Salle students are not permitted to search unauthorized websites.
6. La Salle Academy's network is unified and students are not permitted to change configuration settings, etc.
